DANGEROUS GOODS



Container Relocations cannot transport anything that is listed as a Dangerous Good (as per NZTA Land Transport Rule: Dangerous Goods 2005)

Dangerous Goods are items that have explosive, flammable, toxic, infectious, corrosive, or environmentally hazardous properties.

Dangerous goods are marked or labelled to identify their hazardous properties. They will likely have a diamond-shaped class warning label on them; examples of this can be seen below:
